




Key Findings

From over 9,500 data points across nine categories, including children, criminal justice, economy, education, elections & civic life, health, housing, infrastructure & mobility, and environment & energy.

Annual county growth numbers are strong, but long-term growth varies by region and county

Long term employment growth is strong but not evenly distributed throughout the state

Between 2021 and 2022, the average county experienced:


Incomes are far below the cost of living in almost every county

Economic outcomes vary significantly by county, but many counties struggle.










Percent of people under 18 headed by single parent




